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IT skills pay succumbs to economic conditions, posting first overall decline since mid-2004.

But pay still rising for architecture, methodology/process, database, security, networking/communications, and project management skills and certifications.

Vero Beach, FL, January 27, 2009 – Pay premiums for IT skills, which have risen consistently every calendar quarter since mid-2004, have finally succumbed to a fractured economy, according to the latest quarterly update of Foote Partners' *IT Skills and Certifications Pay IndexTM* of pay for 354 skills and certifications earned by 22,550 IT professionals in the US and Canada.

The average market value for 179 noncertified IT skills dropped 0.5 percent in the last three months of 2008 compared to the prior quarter despite continued pay gains in three key categories: **Management/Methodology/Process; Database;** and **Messaging and Communications** skills. Meanwhile, average pay for 175 IT certifications continued its steady decline that began in 2006, losing another 1 percent in the same period and nearly 5% for the year. There, too, were key significant gains in pay in three certification groups: **Architecture/Project Management; IT Security;** and **Networking.**

“It was inevitable for skills pay to start reflecting the hard times we’re in. This is not the first time in ten years tracking skills and certifications pay and demand that we’ve seen corrections brought on by economic conditions,” notes David Foote, the firm’s co-founder, CEO and Chief Research Officer. “But the big

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difference this time around is the counter-trending, especially in architecture and methodology and process skills. We've never seen anything quite like this before.

“Clearly, an urgent demand for talent in these areas is eclipsing broad, knee jerk reactions to reducing budgets and cutting people, projects and purchases without thinking carefully about the consequences. There are a lot of factors driving this behavior, but all in all it just shows how far IT management has come since they were in this position last time. A very positive thing to see in some very negative conditions in our opinion.”

Continues Foote, “The fact is that employers made mistakes in past downturns---huge miscalculations in the heat of cost cutting--- that hurt them later on. Or should I say that limited their options when the smoke cleared and they were without the experience and specialized skills needed to rebuild the business. Employers are obviously now aware that continuing to invest strategically in IT skills and labor is the smartest thing they can possibly do to make it to the other side of this recession as stronger, undiminished enterprises. They've learned that it's not how much or how little they can getting away with spending and still maintain equilibrium during economic downturns: It's about how smart they're spending what they have. This is one of the true measures of leadership for senior IT and business executives alike, in good or bad times.”

For example, increasing process efficiency through the adoption of software automation and workflow tools is a popular recession budget strategy in 2009, evidenced by *sharp increases in pay and demand for ITIL, CoBIT, and similar expertise* tracked in Foote Partner's survey that are highly valued in facilitating process standardization and change management. While valuable in short range cost reduction initiatives, these are also core enterprise skills with high re-use value long term.

Similarly, with the anticipated escalation in recession-driven mergers and acquisitions creating an enormous amount of integration-related activity, IT architecture and project management expertise are in more demand than ever. “Nothing has been hotter than architecture jobs and skills in the last few years according to our trends research,” notes Foote. “This includes system, network, application, data, information, infrastructure, security, solutions, and, of course, enterprise architects. They will still be hot commodities long after the economy improves. But staffing and talent development in this area does not come easy or cheap. Most employers are well behind the curve. Even those who have invested heavily will tell you that they need more architects. Is this a time to throw up your arms and stop spending on architecture? Absolutely not! You can't afford *not* to rearrange your budget to continue investing what dollars you have in building this kind of

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capability. The benefits are not just long range, as some believe,” insists Foote. “They are right here, right now.”

Summary of Findings

Our analysis of the latest *IT Skills and Certifications Pay IndexTM (ITSCPI)* data and findings will be released in cascading new releases in coming weeks. What follows in this first release of findings is detailed data on individual skills and certifications that have increased, decreased, or maintained the same market value in the near term (3 to 6 months), and by how much.

What is clear from comparing 3-month and 6-month pay performance trends is that there has been a predictable acceleration of activity caused by major events including the collapse of capital markets, financial institutions, and optimism about the future. This has impacted skills pay and demand dramatically, reordering priorities in skills investment, and resulting in increases as well as decreases in investment in individual skills and entire categories. Subsequent news releases from Foote Partners will provide our analyses of these shifting priorities from a big-to-small picture perspective; by industry; by size of enterprise.

What IT skills are increasing/decreasing in value?

Growth or decline in pay for a skill reflects a changing gap between supply and demand for that skill. As a rule, growth indicates demand exceeding supply and will fluctuate over time as supply grows to meet demand. By analyzing the fluctuations in pay performance for a single skill over various time periods, inferences can be made about the market for that skill. Combined with other information---vendor strategies, competitive forces, and customer attitudes and behaviors, for instance---understanding what’s occurring in the current market and formulating projections into the future is possible.

(% Change in Average Median Pay for a Single Noncertified IT Skill)

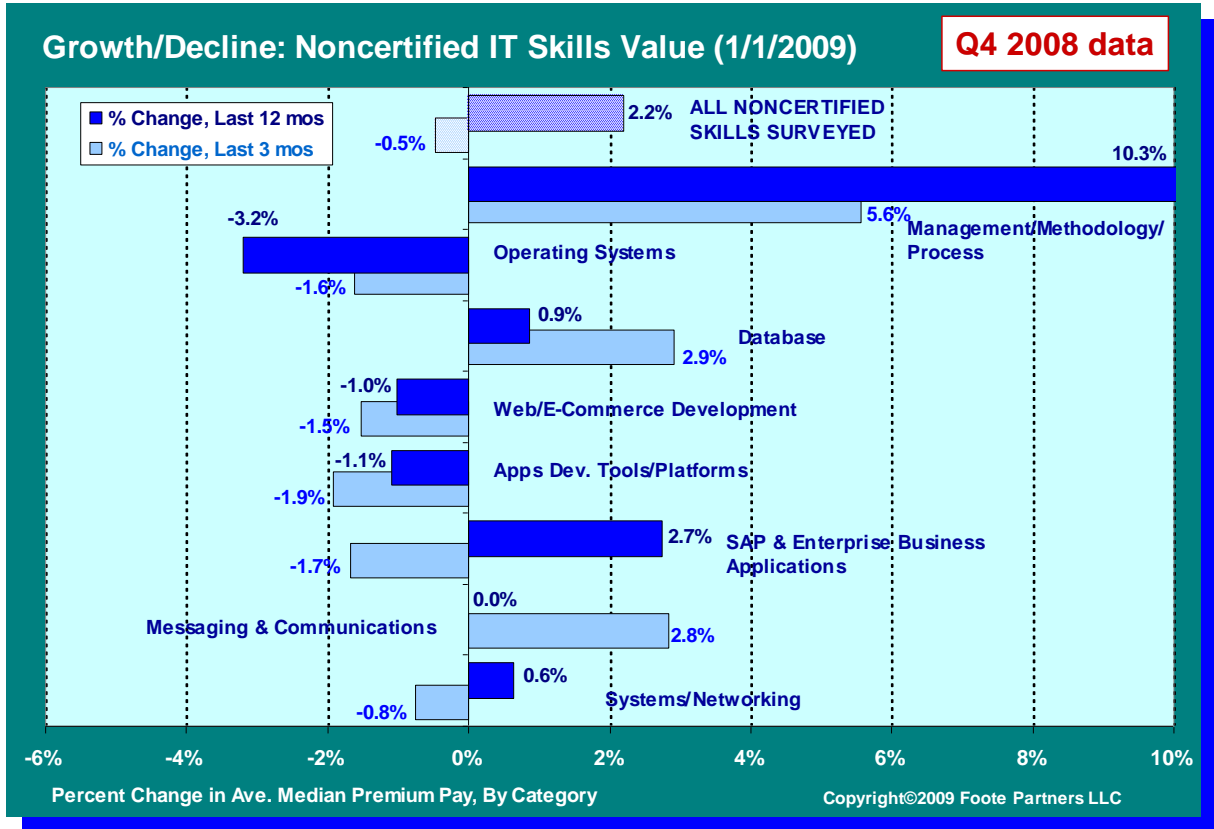

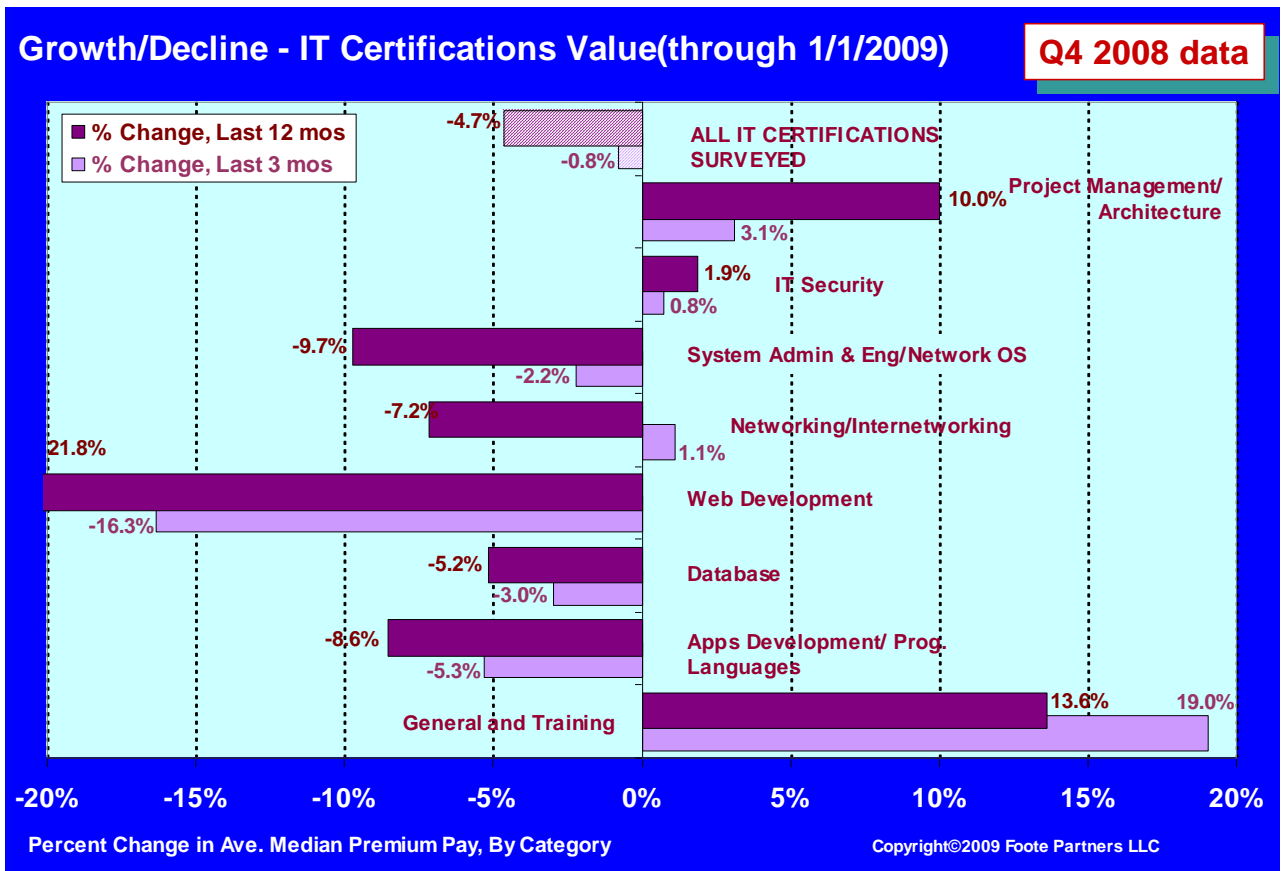

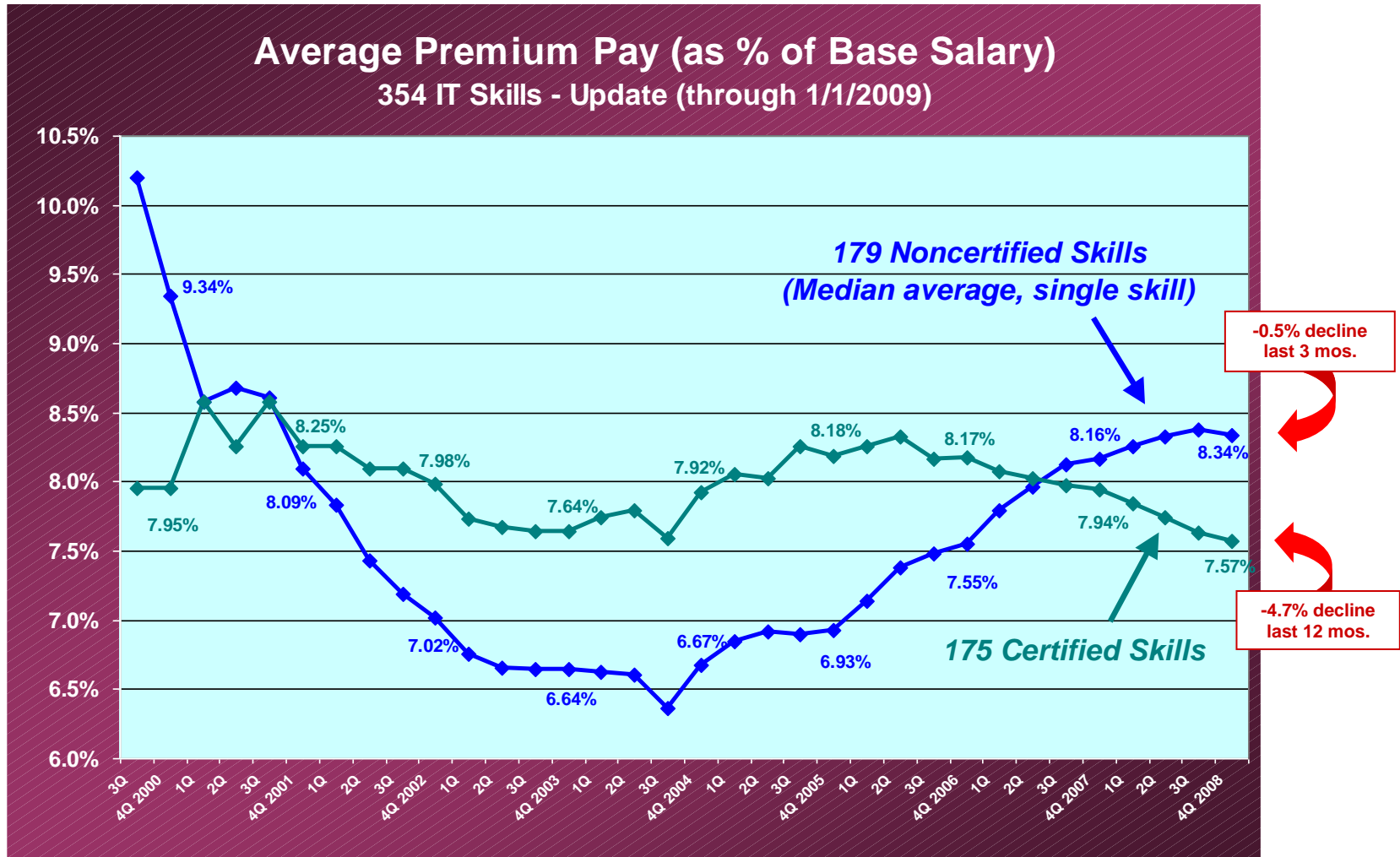

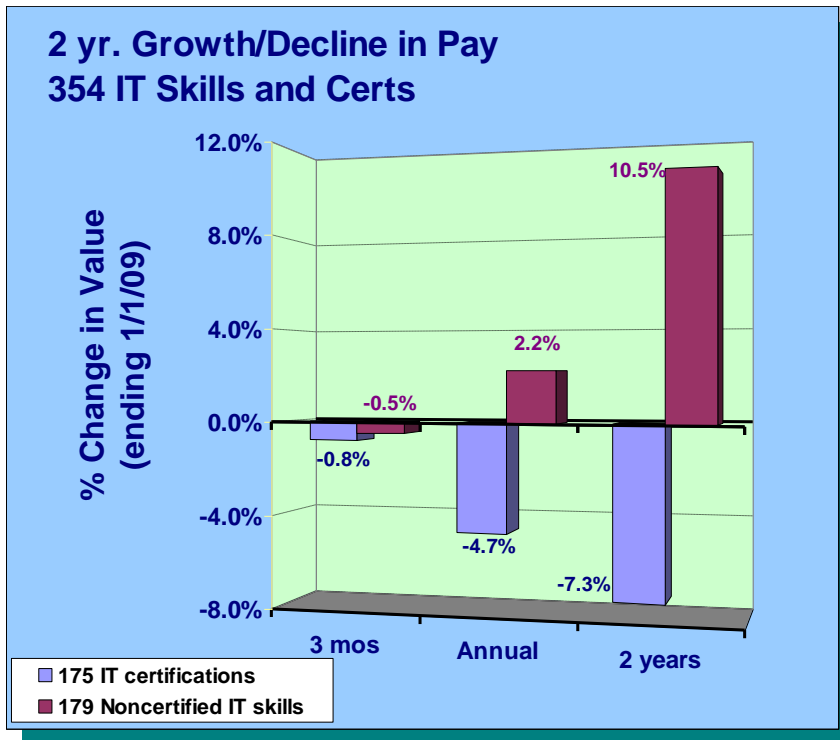

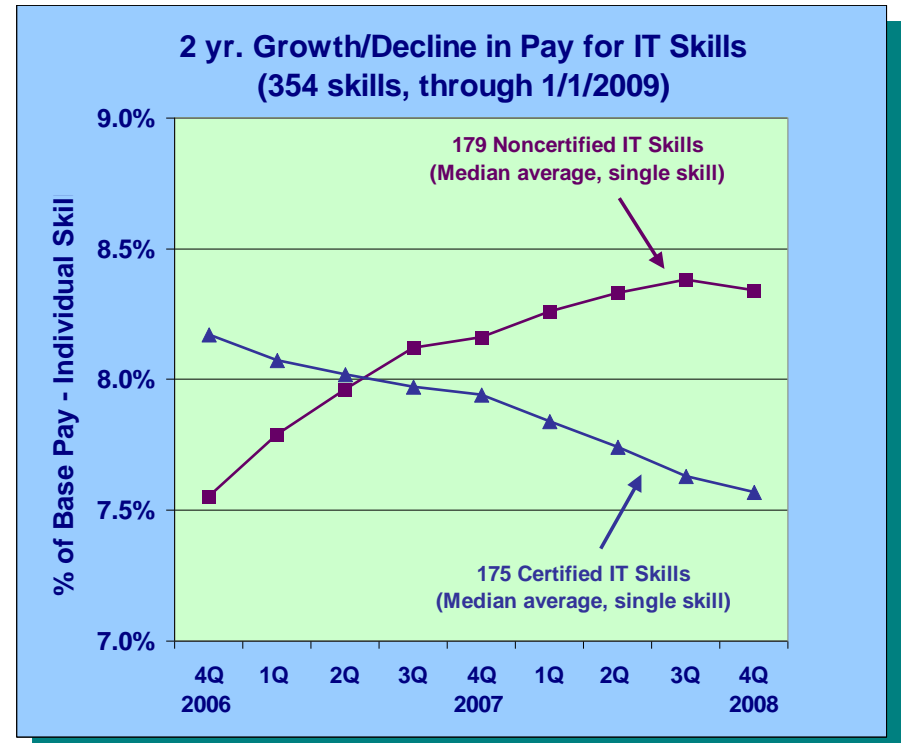

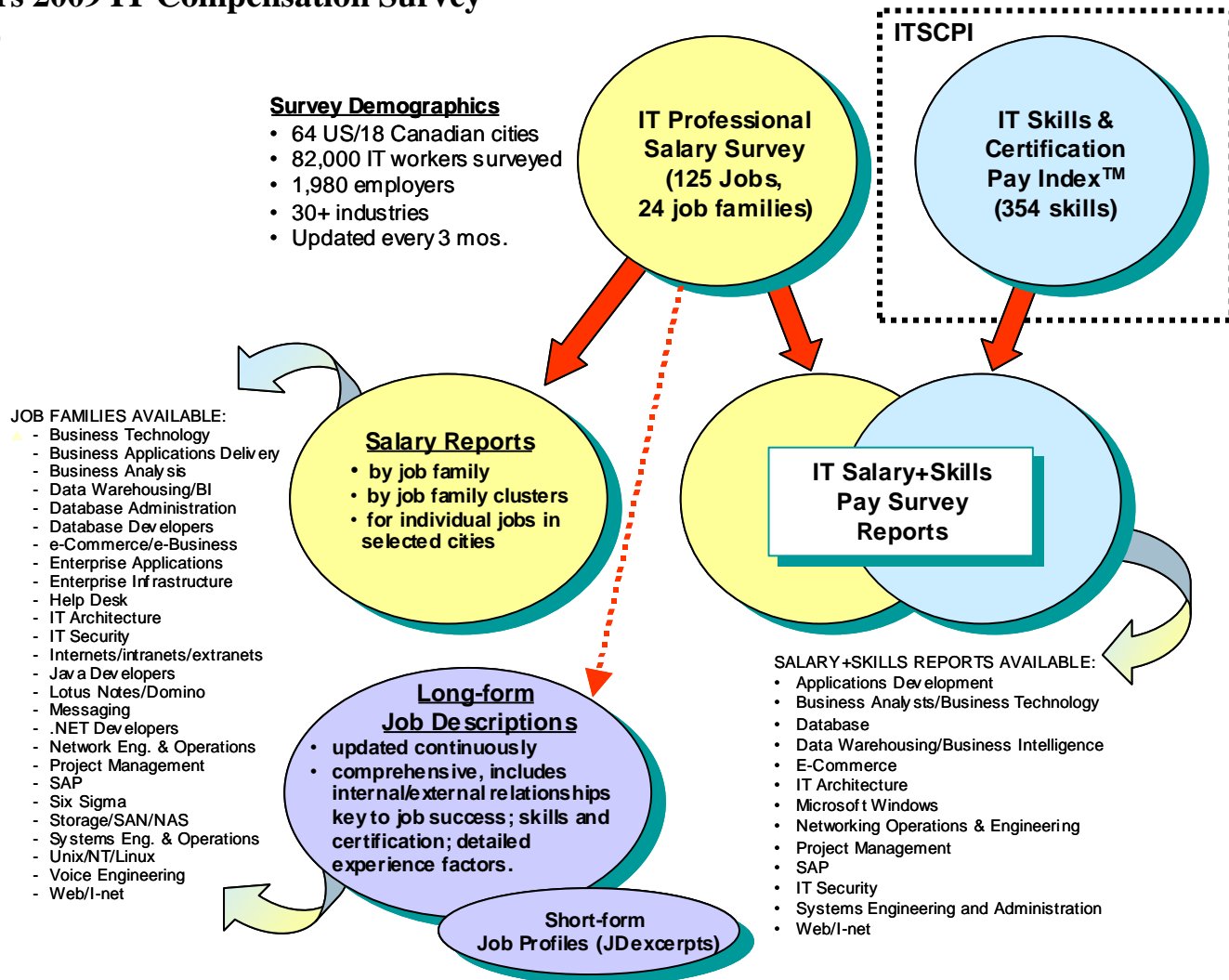

- Given in the form of a bonus, or embedded in base salary to adjust for the presence of a dominant vendor or technology central to job performance (examples: Oracle Database Administrator, Linux Systems Administrator, Unix Programmer, or ABAP Developer).
- Often used to adjust either base pay or total pay in situations where job title does not match actual on-the-job duties and responsibilities, and changing the job title is not an attractive option
- May be used as a reward, recruiting inducement, retention tool, or as a guide for creating consulting rate cards
